YOUR GREEN WASTE CART IS NOW YOUR ORGANICS CART!



To comply with the California law, **Senate Bill 1383**, separate your organics – food scraps, food-soiled paper, and yard trimmings (grass, leaves, and prunings) – from your garbage.

Put these in the **Organics** cart (formerly Green Waste cart) for **WEEKLY** collection on the same day as your garbage. It's that easy!

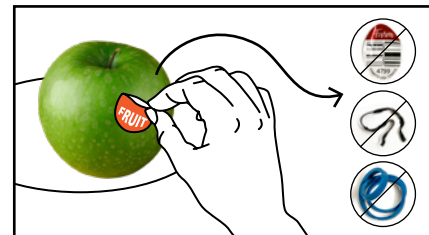
MEET OLIVIA ORGANICS!

HOW TO COLLECT FOOD SCRAPS AND FOOD-SOILED PAPER:



Remove stickers, twist ties, rubber bands, and plastic wrap from food scraps.



Collect food scraps and food-soiled paper in a bowl, recycled container, or kitchen pail.



Line with a paper bag or towel, newspaper, or compostable bag (BPI Certified; ASTM D6400).



Store in a convenient location (under sink, on the countertop, or in the refrigerator or freezer).



Empty daily into your Organics curbside cart for **WEEKLY** collection. Rinse or wipe with paper towel after each use.

Leaves, yard trimmings, clean wood scraps (4" diameter or less)

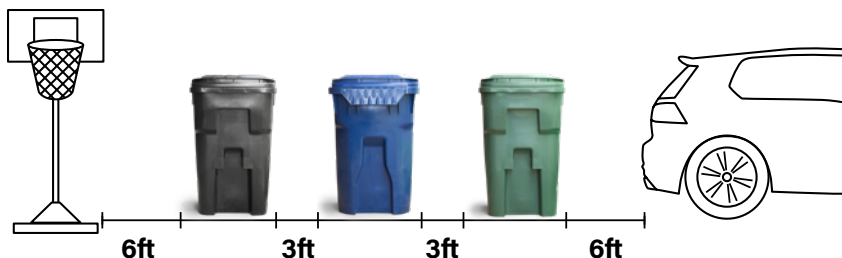

CART SET-OUT

- Carts out by 6:00 AM, including holidays.
- **Cart lids must be closed.** Avoid spills and littering your neighborhood.
- **Cart placement: place carts at the curb with the handle facing your residence.** Do not block sidewalks.
- **Return carts to your property.** This helps keep streets clear, and improves the appearance of your neighborhood!



For best service, place carts at the curb at least **3 feet** apart. Keep carts a minimum of **6 feet** away from cars, boats, and other stationary objects to avoid risk of property damage.

USED OIL AND USED OIL FILTERS PICKUP

USED MOTOR OIL, USED OIL FILTERS, AND COOKING OIL ARE COLLECTED THE SAME DAY AS GARBAGE/ORGANICS.

Place oil in rigid or semi-rigid clear/translucent plastic one-gallon containers.

Maximum limit per collection day is 3 containers.

Oil filters must be drained and placed in a sealed plastic bag.



Place used motor oil, used oil filters, and cooking oil **3 feet** away from carts.

BULKY WASTE PICKUP

ONE PICKUP EVERY 12 MONTHS IS INCLUDED IN YOUR RATE. ADDITIONAL PICKUPS ARE AVAILABLE FOR A FEE.

Items may be picked up in different loads on the same day. Pile size is limited to 5 cubic yards/8'x4'x4', about the size of a couch.

Larger piles are subject to additional fees.

Please keep all bulky waste 6 feet away from stationary objects.

ACCEPTED FOR PICKUP:



Appliances*



E-waste* (TVs and computer monitors)



Tires* (no rims; maximum of 5)



Mattresses



Furniture



Gasoline mowers* (drained of all fluids)



Lawn/tree/shrub prunings



Fluorescent tubes* (4 feet or less in length)

*Place these items to the side of your pile.

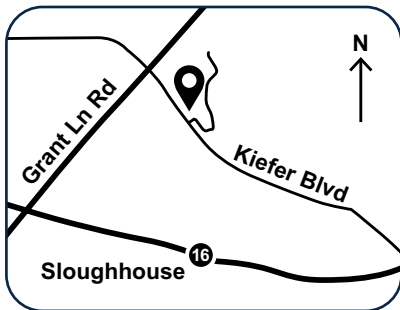

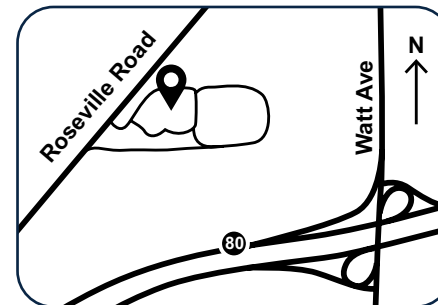
